

## Central Tech CARES Act Eligibility Application

As a student at Central Tech, you **could** be eligible to receive an Emergency Fund Grant. The Cares Act that recently passed congress, is providing emergency grant funds to financially assist students who were actively enrolled in school/college, and are eligible for Title IV aid as of March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Central Tech Students who meet the requirements will be receiving a payment from those funds. These monies are to help cover expenses that you incurred as a result of COVID-19 and Central Tech moving to Distance Learning.

In order for Central Tech to determine if you would be eligible for a payment through the emergency funds process, you would need to complete a 2019/2020 Free Application for Student aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA may be completed at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>. Or you may self certify by meeting the criteria listed below:

Please put a check mark by all criteria that you meet.

- Be enrolled or accepted in a degree or certificate program.
- Have a High School Diploma, GED or completed Home School Program.
- Making satisfactory academic progress.
- Not owe an over payment on Title IV grants or loans.
- Not be in default on a Title IV loans.
- Be a United States citizen or national, permanent resident or other eligible non-citizen.
- Not have fraudulently received Title IV loans in excess of annual or aggregate limits.
- Have repaid Title IV amounts in excess of annual or aggregate limits if obtained inadvertently.
- Have registered for Selective Service. (Males only).
- Have a valid and verifiable Social Security Number.
- Not have a federal or state conviction for drug possession or sale, with certain time limitations.
