## **Central Tech CARES Act Eligibility Application**

As a student at Central Tech, you **could** be eligible to receive an Emergency Fund Grant. The Cares Act that recently passed congress, is providing emergency grant funds to financially assist students who were actively enrolled in school/college, and are eligible for Title IV aid as of March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Central Tech Students who meet the requirements will be receiving a payment from those funds. These monies are to help cover expenses that you incurred as a result of COVID-19 and Central Tech moving to Distance Learning.

In order for Central Tech to determine if you would be eligible for a payment through the emergency funds process, you would need to complete a 2019/2020 Free Application for Student aid (FAFSA).
